### How to Become a Fully Compliant Supplier

### 1. Become a Registered Bidder

After becoming a Registered Bidder, you can then advance your status to become a Fully Compliant Supplier, which allows you to be fully awarded City contracts.

### 2. San Francisco Business Tax Registration


Business Registration is required for all entities that conduct business in SF and determines your tax responsibilities.

### 3. Equal Benefits Declaration

Articles 131 and 132 of the San Francisco Labor and Employment Code requires that all Suppliers to the City and County of San Francisco administer benefits equally to employees with domestic partners and employees with spouses.

## How to Contract for Technology Services

- SFO Information Technology and Telecommunications (ITT)
  - SFO ITT Technology Sourcing Management Group utilizes City's Technology Marketplace Contract (TM3.0) as an efficient purchasing model for the Airport's technology needs. TM3.0 consists of 50+ suppliers with whom the City has negotiated multi-year Term Contracts for as-needed purchases of technology goods and services.
  - **Prospective solution providers** shall partner with existing TM3.0 suppliers to participate in the procurement process with the City / SFO.
  - Current Services Opportunities: Search Engine Optimization Solution, Development / UI UX Professional Services, HR Employee Engagement Retention Solution, Atlassian Confluence Professional Services, Cyber Security Consulting, Safety Management Compliance Tracking Solution, Digital Mapping Solutions, Software Architecture Professional Services, Service Now Consulting Services, Juniper RE / PM Services.





## Technical Proposal Evaluation

### What We Look For

- ✓ Complete and accurate information
- ✓ Respond to technical proposal requirements (format and details)
- ✓ Relevant and verifiable project examples
- ✓ Understanding of the Airport's Strategic Plan, core values, and Delivering Exceptional Projects and how to apply them to the work



### **Oral Interview Evaluation**

### What We Look For

- ✓ Team synergy
- ✓ Key personnel's understanding of their roles and responsibilities.
- ✓ Collective knowledge and experience
- Leadership of the project manager/team lead



### **Debriefs**

Firms may request a debrief after the solicitation is completed to:

- Learn how their proposal was evaluated specifically by each panelist
- Hear feedback on their proposal's strengths and weaknesses
- Review competing proposals

SFO can only provide debriefs and copies of proposals after contract award by the Airport Commission.





## How to Open a Concession Business
